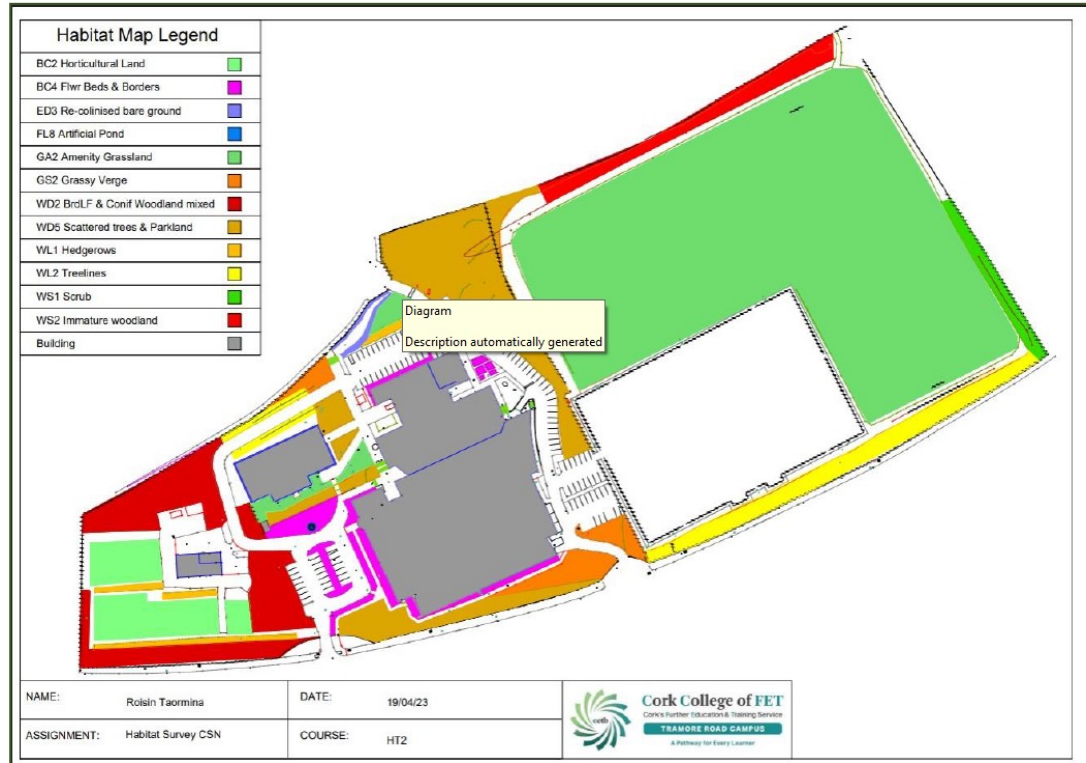
## 2. Environmental Review

## 5. Links to Learning on Campus

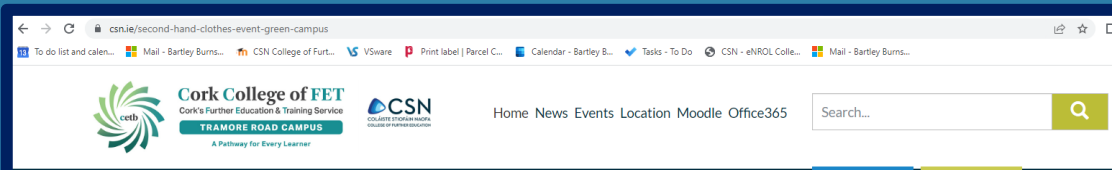
- Our Level 6 students completed a project where they reviewed the bio diversity on site

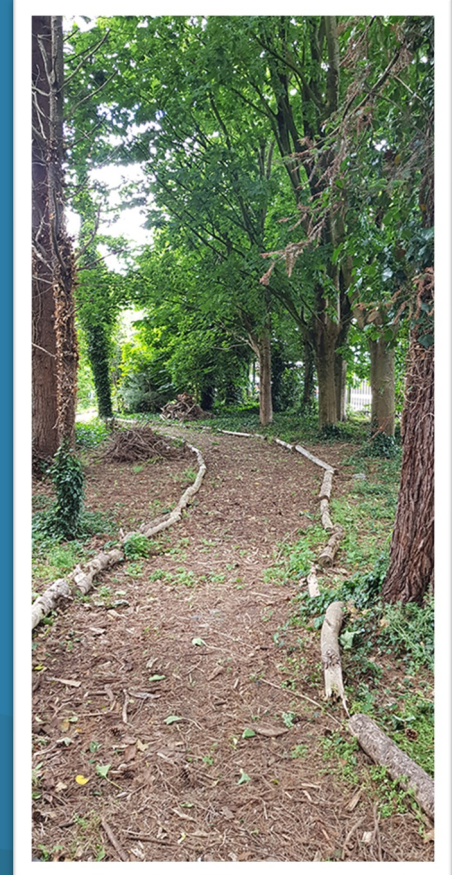

## 7. Green Charter
