1.TRANSPORT OPPORTUNITIES

- In our county, Bacau, there is a multitude of options when it comes to transportation.
- Some of them are more efficient than others but
 you also have to take into consideration the
 average cost of the option you choose, or the
 distance you have to travel in order to get to
 highschool.
- So here are the top options that students gravitate to:





a.Walking

We will start with the most common yet most inexpensive and ecological way of going to school, the good old walk. This is obviously most used by the students who live near the school.



b. Bicycles, scooters and other micromobility devices

This option is used by the students that don't enjoy public transportation or just want to burn some extra calories. This method can become quite fast when instead of riding along with you, the dog is chasing you.



c.Public Transportation

- This method is mainly used by the pupils who still live in the city but farther away from school. Its main advantage is that it can be as cheap as walking because the school can provide a **bus** pass that can be used even on holidays.
- The downside of this method is that due to the early hour, a lot of people choose the same option for being cheap and convenient to use.



d.Personal vehicles and ride sharing

- This method is being used either by students who live far away and whose parents are willing to drop their kids off to school or the ones that got their license and can **drive** themselves. Since the price of gas skyrocketed, many people opted the other options mentioned before.
- With the popularization of ride sharing apps, this became a good option for the people who can afford it.



e.School minibuses

> This is the option used by the pupils that live outside the city. Our county is equipped with around 151 minibuses (84 from the Ministry of Education and 67 from the local public authorities) that provide transportation for students in need of it.

The electrical charging station


- The electrical charging station was installed in the campus of Karpen Highschool in December 2021, on the occasion of its 52nd anniversary.
- With a power of 21 KW (kilowatts), the station allows the charging of electric cars and was made with the support of electrician students, as a project work.
- It will be useful, as didactic equipment, for the students who are preparing in the qualification of Auto Electrician Electronist Technician, but it is also functional for charging the electric cars that come to the campus.

- The project aimed at the **ecological and aesthetic reconstruction** of the space related to the entrance to building A and the canteen of Karpen Highschool. The activities within the project:
- Arranging a canopy at the entrance to building A made of hanging and decorative plants, thus providing a pleasant environment for visitors, students and teachers.




This helps us not only to breath a **purified air** but also to save energy by not using the air conditionner machines during summer, due to the shadowing and the fresh air of the plants.

Raising ecological curtains (green walls) on the facades of the building A (the main building) and the canteen, structured on a support of galvanized wire mesh and populated with fast-growing hanging plants.

- Our gardens are maintained daily and carefully watered by the drip irrigation system which also helps in sustainability and water saving.
- Also within the "Green Gold of Karpen" project, 30 species of trees and shrubs were planted, each with an information panel with pictures and a brief presentation of it.
